Project Status Update

Over the past six weeks, the construction team has been working hard preparing the Perley and Rideau Veterans' Health Centre (Perley Rideau) campus for the Seniors' Village Housing Project. Preparations include: developing temporary parking lots, erecting site signage, installing way-finding and construction fencing, modifying the Russell Road campus entrance, and developing the relocated main entrance to the main campus building.

At present, excavation and footings for Building "B" are being installed near Russell Road, where the baseball diamond was located. The team is working diligently to complete aspects of this project before the inclement winter weather arrives.

At the Building "A" site, the existing building entrance canopy has been demolished, and the windows along the north face of the main building have been covered for protection, during the construction period. The underground site utilities for Building "A" are currently being installed, and in the first quarter of 2012, the installation of the building's deep foundation system will begin.

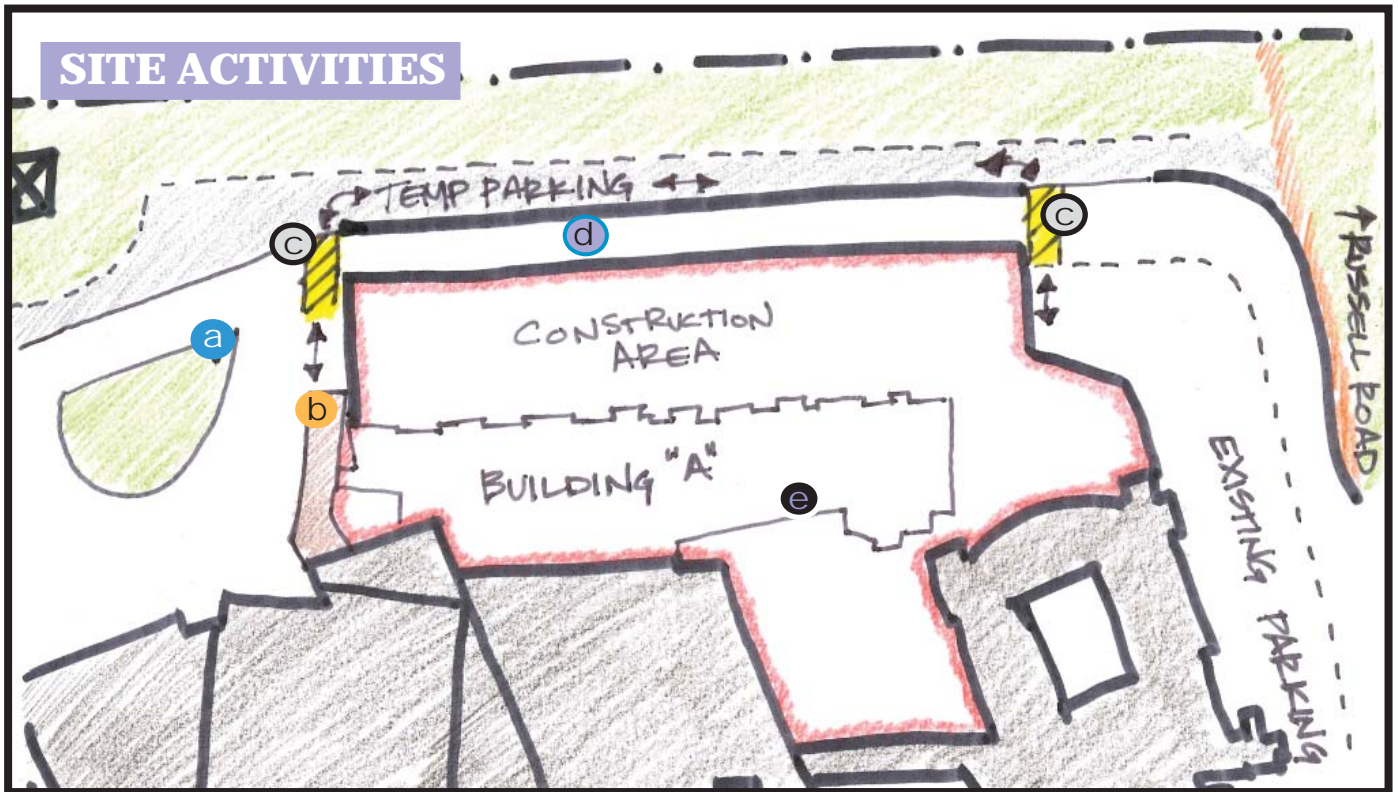
What's happening near Russell Road, north of the campus' entrance?

Many of the campus visitors and staff have been inquiring about the construction work being completed along Russell Road, north of the campus entrance. This project involves the installation of the underground utilities that will service the new Building "B". Over the next several weeks, there will be underground utility work being performed. Construction will cross the campus' entrance coming off of Russell Road.

Please pay attention to any signage or traffic flaggers. The construction team has been made aware of employee shift changes and will direct traffic to alleviate congestion on the campus.

As a reminder, please plan extra time when commuting to and from the campus.

- a** **Flag Pole & Bike Rack**
The existing flag pole & bike rack have been successfully moved to their new location, near the relocated main entrance to the Perley Rideau campus.
- b** **Relocated Main Entrance**
The relocated main entrance has been in use since November 16th, and will continue to provide access to the main building for the duration of the construction project on the Perley Rideau campus.
- c** **Crosswalk**
Please follow pedestrian access signage & routes. Pedestrians should cross the roadway, into the temporary parking lot and walk towards Russell Road for access to existing parking areas or bus stops.
- d** **Roadways**
The existing roadway will remain open during construction for operations, visitor and construction traffic. For your safety, please do not walk along the roadway.
- e** **Steeple**
For the duration of the project, a protective barrier will encase the steeple for the Perley Rideau chapel.
